Chapter 12: TOWN BUILDING CODE

Section 12.04: STATE CODES ADOPTED

(1) Electrical code, Wisconsin Administrative Code Comm. SPS 316.

(a) By local ordinance, only the following persons shall be permitted to engage in electrical work in the Town of Neenah:

1. *Electrical contractors:* Any State of Wisconsin licensed and insured "Electrical Contracting" firm that employs at least one full-time employee of which holds a valid State "Master Electrician" certification.

2. *Homeowners:* Any homeowner may personally perform electrical work in his owner-occupied single-family dwelling on the same premises, to include structures and accessory buildings, beyond the main electrical panel disconnect, upon proving his competency to comply with all rules and regulations as set forth in the State adopted Electrical Code (SPS 316 and the current State adopted National Electrical Code) and he complies with the National Electrical Code Article 100 Definition of a "Qualified Person", i.e. one who has skills and knowledge related to the construction and operation of the electrical equipment and installations and has received safety training to recognize and avoid the hazards involved.
